Data categories (Art. 14 relevant)	Last name, first name, contact details, address data, communication data, project data, billing data
Affected groups of people	Customers, project participants
Recipients of data (Art. 14 relevant):	Management, Assistance, Sales, Project Manager, Project Members
International transfer	As a rule, there is no transfer of data outside the EU. For online meetings, software products from US service providers may be used. Corresponding contractual regulations such as the EU standard contractual clauses exist with these service providers.

Duration of storage	The storage expires as soon as the purpose for the storage ceases to apply and there is no statutory retention period against it.
